# Renaming Large Numbers: Decimal Millions 

You will sometimes need to rename large numbers using decimals. For example, we can rename 3450000 as being about 3.5 million.

The number to the left of the The digits to the right of the decimal names the whole number. decimal names the part of the number.

For example: In the number 43431509

- There are 43 whole millions
- There are 431 thousands

We would write this as 43.4 million

Don't forget rounding rules:
5 or more - Raise the score
4 or less - Give it a rest! The decimal will go here - between


To find out if we will keep 4 in the hundred thousands place or round it up to 5 , we need to look at the ten thousands place and use our rounding rules.
